
Welcome to the AA AE Community!

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AAAE Member Portal



The AAEE Member Portal is an internal website and resource center only available to AAEE Members. This is where you can access resources such as:

 - Register for **virtual AAEE events***, such as the Professional Development series, and the **annual AAEE conference****.
 - **Virtual events are ALWAYS FREE for AAEE members.*
 - ***AAEE members receive a special, members-only discount on conference registration.*
- **Membership Directory**
 - Keep your **contact information up-to-date** and **connect with other AAEE members!**
 - **Did you know?** You can directly message other AAEE members directly in the Member Portal. Navigate to the Directory Tab, click Member Directory, click on a member you'd like to contact, and click the Send Message button in the bottom right corner.

AAAE Listserv



The AA AE listserv is a way to **connect** and **communicate with other members directly**. Feel free to send relevant information to the entire membership by emailing aaae@gaggle.email and one of our staff members will approve your communication.

These communications should be **clear, concise,** and **well contextualized** in the field of arts administration, or a relevant field.

Communications can be opportunities, surveys, or general questions or comments. You can respond to other members' emails to the listserv by replying all or reply directly to the sender by hitting just reply.

AAAE Staff and Board Members will also utilize the listserv to communicate with the entire membership, to promote or remind about events and deadlines, share AA AE news or general AA AE information.


